Students meet the general eligibility requirements for both scholarships if they:

- are of Asian and/or Pacific Islander ethnicity as defined by the U.S. Census;
- are a citizen, national, or legal permanent resident of the United States;
- are enrolling in a U.S. accredited college or university as a full-time, degree-seeking, first-year student
- have demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular, or other activities

Each scholarship has specific additional requirements, including financial need and minimum GPA.
