APIASF Awards More Than \$1.2 Million in Scholarships to Deserving AAPI Students

The Asian & Pacific Islander American Scholarship Fund (APIASF) recently awarded more than \$1.2 million dollars in scholarships to support Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) students in attaining higher education for the upcoming academic year. This is the largest amount distributed through the APIASF general scholarship program to-date. APIASF welcomed more than 500 diverse and outstanding AAPI students to the 2011-2012 APIASF scholarship class, all of whom will be attending more than 200 colleges and universities across the country. More than half of the scholarship recipients come from families that live at or below the poverty line and more than half are the first in their families to attend college.

The Scholars were selected from more than 5,000 completed applications by volunteers from across the country who read and reviewed each submission. Recipients demonstrated strong leadership skills and an ongoing commitment to community service.
